

Grounds Maintenance Volunteer

About the role

The beautiful gardens at St Richard's are a place of joy and tranquillity for everyone who uses them, including patients and their families.

We're looking for volunteers to help keep our gardens well-maintained and looking lovely all-year round.

We ask volunteers to give a minimum of four hours per week in one shift, Monday to Friday, between 8am and 5pm. Hours can be flexible to suit each volunteer.



What will you do in this role?

Roles may include:

- · Weeding and clearing dead plants
- Sewing donated seeds and bedding-in donated plants
- Tidying beds, borders, pots and hanging baskets
- Watering plants during summer months
- Cleaning and varnishing outdoor furniture, fences and sheds
- · Keeping patios and paths weed-free
- Clearing and sweeping paths outside the hospice's main entrance and car park
- Trimming of hedges around barriers
- Pressure washing paths and patios
- Mowing lawns using ride-on and push mowers

What are the qualities needed for this role?

We are looking for volunteers who are:

- Friendly and approachable
- Have a basic knowledge of, and interest in, gardening
- Physically fit as shifts are mostly spent standing and walking, with regular breaks
- Happy to work alone and as part of a team
