About the role

Our shops and warehouse receive hundreds of items of homewares a week, donated by generous supporters.

Donations must be sorted and prepared for sale before heading to our shops or online store to raise funds for our care.

We are appealing for volunteers to help us process homewares, such as crockery and ornaments, at our warehouse in Leigh Sinton.

We ask volunteers to give one half-day shift a fortnight, however we can be flexible on days and times.

What will you do in this role?

In this role, volunteers will take on tasks such as:

- separating saleable items from unsaleable items and items for recycling
- separating and preparing items for sale, including cleaning, polishing and inspecting for damage
- identifying unique items
- ensuring all passageways, gangways and working areas are kept clean and clear of obstruction

What are the qualities needed for this role?

We are looking for volunteers who:

- have an interest in homewares
- work well as part of a busy team
- have an eye for detail
- are physically fit and able to lift boxes and bags of donations
- have good communication skills
- have a friendly manner
- are enthusiastic and passionate about their volunteer role
- are organised and can follow procedures in place at the warehouse
- can build relationships with customers and other volunteers
